S.No.	Particulars
1.	To prepare the students in such a way so that they become capable and confident Disaster Management professionals at the end of the program.
2.	To give the students the knowledge and skills necessary to plan, create, and implement disaster management plans and strategies.
3.	To help students comprehend the theories, resources, and abilities necessary for Disaster Management research, analysis, and application to the successful operation of business.
4.	To enable the students to gain acumen, insight and through knowledge relating to the various aspects of Disaster Management.
5.	Provide a platform for the improvement of critical thinking skills from the viewpoint of a professional in disaster management.
6.	To help students develop the capacity to make thoughtful decisions by considering various viewpoints and their effects on disaster management.

ELEGIBILITY;

Graduation in any stream with min 50% marks. A relaxation of 5% in the eligibility criteria shall be admissible to the bonafide SC/ST applicants of Madhya Pradesh only. A relaxation of 5% in eligibility will also be applicable to Physically Challenged (*Nishaktjan*) as defined by M.P.Government.

Candidates who have appeared in final year of their graduation examination can also apply. Admission will be finalized if the result is declared before **July 01th 2023** in the admission year and the candidate secures min. required % of marks as mentioned above.

AGE LIMIT:

As per the government rules the upper age limit for male candidates for admission to undergraduate courses is 23 years whereas for postgraduate degree courses it is 28 years as on **July 01, 2023**. A relaxation of three years in upper age limit for SC / ST / OBC and physically challenged candidate shall be provided for the applicants of Madhya Pradesh only. For candidate belonging to physically challenged category upper age limit for admission to Graduate and Post Graduate courses will be 30 and 35 years, respectively as on **July 01, 2023**.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

The admissions will be done as per merit in the entrance test conducted by the University.

SEATS: 60 (reservation as per state Govt. rules).

DURATION: Four Semesters (02 Years)
